Dancing Behind the Scenes

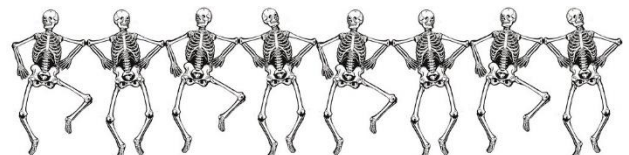
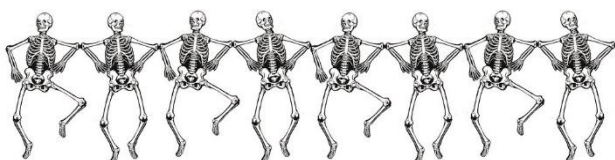
